On the Farm

Currently the farm is in a relatively quiet period, we are split grading our potato seed ready for planting which will start in March/April. We have 10,000 tons from the 2021 potato crop in store ready to go to our customers Kettle Crisps, Lamb Weston for McDonald's Chips and Bartletts for rooster potato. We are also currently lifting sugar beet for British Sugar. We are also preparing fields ready to drill our Spring crops.

January/February is usually a period when we are audited by Red Tractor to make sure our products are compliant to sell to the supermarkets.



Winter Wildlife

With the trees stripped bare of leaves and the park quiet during our shutdown, spotting animals becomes easier. The muntjac deer was introduced into the UK from China in the 20th century. A very small, stocky deer, the muntjac deer is about the same size as a medium dog. It is gingery-brown, with a pale underside, males have darker stripes in their face, and small, single-pointed antlers.


East of England Tourism Awards
